Dear Region XX Band Directors,

Here is the contest information for April 19-21, 2017.

### **Contest Site**

Cedar Hill High School  
#1 Longhorn Blvd.  
Cedar Hill, TX. 75104

### **Directions**

#### **Coming from Dallas US-67 S**

Take US-67 South into Cedar Hill and take the Cooper St. Exit. Turn Left onto Cooper St. and go under the US-67 over pass. The school will be directly in front of you on the east side of US-67.

#### **Coming from Midlothian US-67 N**

Take US-67 North into Cedar Hill and take the Tidwell/Cooper St. Exit on the right. Continue onto US-67 S frontage road past the Tidwell stop sign until you get to the second stop sign which is Cooper St. Turn right into the school parking lot and proceed to the security gate.

### **Unloading and Loading**

Buses will drop off students in front of the Longhorn statue by the Performance Arts Center (PAC) on arrival. Buses will need to park in the location on the map marked for bus parking by the marching band tower. Large equipment can be unloaded in the loading dock next to the PAC but please remember that no equipment will be moved in or out of the performance hall while a performance is in progress. The loading dock is for loading and unloading only so please instruct your truck drivers not to leave the truck parked in the loading area. After unloading equipment, all trucks should move out of the loading area and park with the buses. The bus pick-up point is same as the drop off point by the PAC. Please inform your bus drivers of the time and place they are to pick you up. Busses are to move to the pick-up point only at the assigned time following the completion of your sight reading performance.

### **Supervision**

School will be going on so make sure your students are supervised and quiet in the hallways.

## **Equipment**

Percussion Equipment:

Cedar Hill High School will provide the following percussion equipment:

Concert Bass Drum (bring your own mallet)

Timpani – set of 4

Xylophone

Vibraphone

Marimba

Chimes

Gong

You will need to provide your own snares, cymbals, accessory instruments, toms, sticks, and mallets plus any equipment not listed above that you may need. Bass drum and bells will be provided in the sight-reading room. Snare drum, suspended cymbal, crash cymbals and triangle will not be provided.

## **Food**

No eating facilities are available on campus during the contest.

## **Dressing**

Cedar Hill High School will not be able to furnish any dressing rooms. Plan to arrive and depart in uniform.

## **FORMS**

You must have the "**Statement of Compliance**" and **Form 1** on file BEFORE your band may perform. If these are ready now, please mail in advance to Tonya Armstrong, 5547 Nacogdoches Trail, Grand Prairie, TX. 75052. Otherwise, bring them with you and turn in to the press box.

## **Contest OFFICE**

The contest office is located next to the band hall. Directors will need to check in as soon as you arrive. Please bring 3 complete sets of original judge's scores (with measures numbered), three copies of your seating chart/stage set-up, and your Form 1 (signed by an administrator). We suggest that you leave your students on the bus while you check-in. Signs will be posted directing you to the check-in area (see map for location). Your band will be assigned a monitor to lead you through the entire contest at this time. Your comment sheets and trophies will be available in the Jazz Large Ensemble Room next to the band hall.
